Over 150 pieces comprised mostly of student art pieces, purchased at annual end-of-year student art shows. Some faculty works.









Leigh Lane Edwards Collection of Contemporary Art



Exhibitors are encouraged to assist the gallery in determining the appropriate security devices (if necessary) for securing their pieces; otherwise it is assumed that the security device(s) (if any) prepared by the gallery is (are) sufficient. The gallery is not staffed during scheduled hours.


