Over 150 pieces comprised mostly of student art pieces, purchased at annual end-of-year student art shows. Some faculty works.

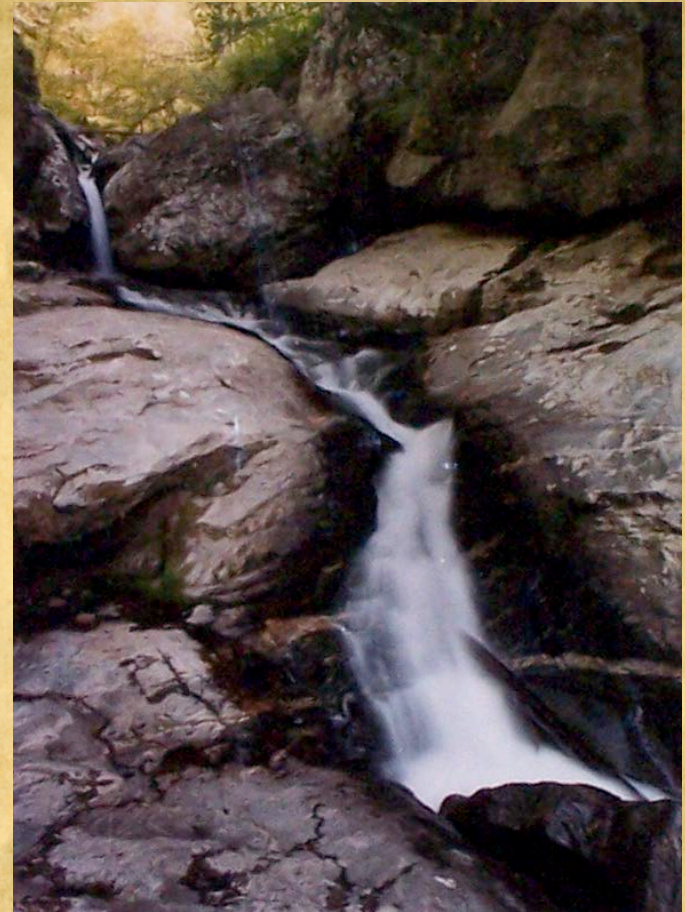




Leigh Lane Edwards Collection of Contemporary Art

The parties hereby agree as follows:

A. Agency and Purposes

The exhibitor appoints the Looking Glass Gallery as agent for the purpose of exhibition, advertisement, and promotion of an exhibition of his/her works entitled _____ with a list of titles, media and dimensions, scheduled for exhibition dates _____

B. Terms of Agreement

The exhibitor and the gallery agree to adhere closely to the deadlines and guidelines set forth in this document. Failure by the artist to supply requested information, photographs, or to complete agreed upon tasks may result in cancellation of the exhibition by the Student Union Arts Committee or will relieve the Student Union Arts Committee of responsibility to provide services contingent on requested information and/or artists involvement.

C. Responsibility for Loss or Damage

The exhibitor must supply no less than 14 days prior to the exhibition to the Looking Glass Gallery Committee Chair a complete list of all works to be exhibited (title, dimension, media, date and value). Insurance for borrowed object(s) is not provided by LGG. If object(s) is/are damaged, it is at the discretion of LGG and PSU Student Programs to work with and compensate exhibitor for damages. If insurance information is not supplied, the Plemmons Student Union assumes no liability for loss or damage of works exhibited in the gallery.

Appropriate efforts will be made to secure and/or mount all works; however, there is no guarantee that damage or loss may not occur. Exhibitors are encouraged to assist the gallery in determining the appropriate security devices (if necessary) for securing their pieces; otherwise it is assumed that the security device(s) (if any) prepared by the gallery is (are) sufficient. The gallery is not staffed during scheduled hours.

D. Additional Responsibilities of the Exhibitor

- Exhibitor will supply the Student Union Arts Committee no less than 14 days prior to the exhibit opening with a complete list of all works, including titles, media, dates and dimensions to be used for producing title cards and press
